Adulteration of Human and Animal Food

Notice to Producers and Grain Handling Facilities

Treated seeds are stained so they can be distinguished from untreated seeds used for human and animal consumption. It is unlawful to mix treated seeds with untreated seeds (i.e. soybeans, corn, wheat, etc.) that will be used for human or animal consumption. If treated seeds are mixed with untreated seeds/grain it is considered adulteration and is no longer suitable for human or animal consumption. Adulteration of human and animal food may be punishable by up to 3 years of imprisonment, \$10,000 fine, or both.

According to the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act a food shall be deemed to be adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substances which may render it injurious to health.

According to the Commercial Feed Act a commercial feed shall be deemed to be adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance which may render it injurious to health.
