Introductory Industrial Locomotive Operator Training will cover Locomotive Familiarization; Diesel Engine Descriptions, Components, Status Indicators, and Protective Devices; Starting and Preparing for Service Including Ground Inspections, Control Panel and Switches, Engine Control Stand, Start Station, Fluid Levels and Fuel Tanks and more.
